Articles may be submitted in the English, French, Spanish or Italian languages, and will not be accepted for publication by other foreign or Italian journals. Acceptance will depend on the favourable opinion of experts of the journal's Editorial Board, who reserve the right to make suggestions for modifications to the authors. The editor of the journal will communicate acceptance or rejection to the author. The journal assumes no responsibility for the contents of the articles it publishes.

Text preparation

Authors are encouraged to submit their text by e-mail (rivtrop@iao.florence.it) containing the final version of the paper. Please observe the following criteria:

- Specify what software was used, including which release (e.g. Word).
- Text, tables and illustrations should be supplied on separate files.
- Illustrations must be provided in a form suitable for reproduction without retouching. Illustrations should be permitted reduction, with lines drawn proportionally thicker and symbols larger than required in the printed version.

Copyright

Upon acceptance, the copyright of a paper becomes the property of Journal of Agriculture and Environment for International Development. Permission to reprint in any form contributions or parts of contributions can therefore be given only by the Journal.

Arrangement of paper

1. A short title (up to 40 characters including spaces) should be followed by a listing of the author name, affiliation, full postal address and telephone and fax numbers. Respective affiliations and address of co-authors should be clearly indicated.
2. The abstract (up to 20 lines in length) in the original language of the paper.
3. The keywords must be limited to 3 or 4.
4. Main body of text suitably divided under headings. *Latin expression* must be written in Italic.
5. Bibliographical notes should be included in the text in parentheses with the author's name in capital and the year of publication; should the authors be more than two, the name of the first author must be followed by the abbreviation *et al.*
6. References.
7. Tables and Figures (each on separate sheet and numbered).
8. Footnotes where necessary (numbered consecutively).
9. Illustrations (each on separate sheet containing no text). Captions to illustrations (on a separate sheet).

References

References should include only the works in the text and should be listed alphabetically at the end of the paper conform to the current journal style:

For books: Ongaro L., 1998. *Land unit mapping for land evaluation*. Istituto Agronomico per l'Oltremare, Relazioni e monografie agrarie, nuova serie n° 115, Florence, 50 p.

For journals: Ongaro L., 1995. *Rangelands evaluations in Southern Tunisia*. Istituto Agronomico per l'Oltremare, Rivista di Agricoltura Subtropicale e Tropicale, Vol. 89 (2): 251-264

Footnotes

Footnotes should be indicated in the text by superior Arabic numerals which run consecutively through the paper. They should be grouped together in a section at the end of the text in numerical order.

Tables

Tables should be numbered consecutively in Arabic numerals and given a caption. Notes and references within tables should be included with the tables, separately from the main text.

Illustrations

All graphs, diagrams, drawings and photographs (slides or black-and white or colour print) should be referred as Figures, which should be numbered in Arabic numerals and placed on separate sheet at the end of the manuscripts. All illustrations must have captions.

Proofs

The proofs of accepted paper will be supplied to the authors for correction and must return within 7 days. Only the first proof will be submitted for correction by the author.
